

## **Instructor, Speech-Language Pathology**

The University of South Dakota is accepting applications for a full-time, nine-month, speech-language pathology instructor position in the Department of Communication Sciences and Disorders, with possibility of summer employment. The expected start date is August 22, 2018.

**Qualifications and Responsibilities:** Master's degree in speech-language pathology, ASHA CCC/SLP, and possession of or eligibility for South Dakota state licensure in speech-language pathology.

Responsibilities include teaching undergraduate courses in the Communication Sciences and Disorders curriculum, supervising speech-language pathology clinical practicum, coordinating off-site placements for speech-language pathology internships, and serving on departmental and related committees. Salary is commensurate with qualifications.
