Applying Evidence-Based Assessment and Therapy Methods to Standards-based IEP Goals and Objectives

Course Description: Speech and language services in schools must be educationally relevant to develop the communication skills needed to meet grade-level curriculum standards. SLPs have specialized knowledge in identifying communication skills needed to meet educational standards, analyzing the curriculum for speech/language skills, comparing those expectations to the student's skills, and developing evidence-based interventions to build competence in the curriculum. This presentation will provide a framework for SLPs to infuse the curriculum into all aspects of service provision.

She has been employed as a speech-language pathologist, diagnostician, and instructional specialist in public schools for 20 years.
