Qualifications: Must be licensed to practice speech-language pathology by the SD Board of Examiners for Speech- Language Pathology and hold at least a master's degree from an accredited institution. SLPs who held a speech-language certificate from SD DOE as of July 1, 2012 must have at least a bachelor's degree in speech pathology.

Supervision: SLP will work under the direct supervision of the NCSEC Director. Performance evaluations will be completed by the director and school district administration.

Duties and Job Responsibilities:

1. Participate in speech/language screenings.
2. Assist with and conduct appropriate hearing screenings for member districts.
3. Conduct appropriate speech/language evaluations for referred children.
4. Participate in placement meetings to determine eligibility for special education services.
5. Assist with development of IEPs and IFSPs.
6. Attend appropriate IEP and IFSP meetings.
7. Develop an appropriate schedule which will meet the needs of the students, teachers, and school district.
8. Provide speech/language services to eligible students in Least Restrictive Environment.
9. Complete and maintain records and reports of each child.
10. Work with school district teaching staff and parents of individual cases.
11. Transmit paperwork in a timely manner.
12. Attend cooperative in-services and abide by cooperative policies and procedures.
13. Perform other duties and functions as requested by the Director
