Our current team (2023-24 school year) is comprised of 42 Speech Language Pathologists (SLPs) and 1 Speech Language Pathology Assistant (SLPA).

Five Year Plan

The Sioux Falls School District has developed a 5-year plan to continue to expand our SLP team to support student growth and support the speech and language needs of our students.

IEP Facilitators

In an effort to give SLPs more time to work with students, the Sioux Falls School District employs "IEP Facilitators" to support SLPs and other Special Education Staff with IEP paperwork and setting up IEP meetings.

Continuing Education

The Sioux Falls School District offers SLPs many opportunities for professional development. These include District planned professional development each year, opportunities to attend local professional development opportunities, opportunities to attend national professional development opportunities once tenured.

Materials

The Sioux Falls School District recognizes the importance of proper materials in an SLPs success. This is why they provide SLPs a Purchase-Card (P-Card) with \$200 to spend each year on materials needed as well as budget available for other needed materials (i.e. standardized assessments).
